Mathematics

Throughout this term the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will be covered. Measurement will be explored this term along with time, length, distance and data. We will be exploring this through our theme of flight.

English

Throughout Term 2 the students will relate ideas; express opinion, preferences and appreciation of texts; and include relevant details from learnt topics, topics of interest or texts. They group, logically sequence and link ideas. They will use language features including topicspecific vocabulary, and/or visual features and features of voice.

HASS

This term we are continuing to explore history and perspectives of Australia's past. Throughout term one we explored colonisation and researched the reasons people were sent to Australia while starting to explore Aboriginal history and life from their perspective.

Science

Throughout term 2 we are focusing on forces and looking at design thinking and the design process. This will allow us to be prepared for term 3 learning when we are exploring the Paralympics.

Health & PE

Welcome to Term 2 and I hope you all had a relaxing break. This term during the PE/Health program your child will experience and explore various skills/techniques, rules and concepts involved with a range of sports and games.

3-4 Arts

This term in the arts students will be continuing their work with visual before moving onto media art. They will be continuing their landscapes which are inspired by the work of Georgia O'Keefe before moving onto some mixed media artwork inspired by Australian artist Peter Drew. Students will then get to take some inspiration from their peers and work on animating the sculptures designed and created by the younger students.

3-4 Auslan

In Auslan this term students will be focusing on weather signs. They will learn to describe various weather conditions before putting together a weather report that they will film using the green screen and iPads. Students participating in the signing choir will continue practicing the Australian National Anthem for their audition into the Festival of Music.
